


Beach Bliss

Come fall, Crystal Cove State Park breathes a tiny sigh of relief. The dwindling beach crowds and stillpleasant weather make autumn the ideal season to explore this untouched-by-time stretch of coast between Newport Beach and Laguna Beach. If you can't snag a reservation for one of the 38 restored vintage cottages, visit Cottage 35 just before 11 a.m. on any given day to check for cancellations. But even without staying overnight, a day in the park still feels like a vacation.

Start your morning with coffee and warm beignets on the sand at Beachcomber Café. Next, explore the tidepools, go bird-watching, or join one of Crystal Cove Conservancy's science hikes or historic district walking tours (both offered the fourth Saturday of the month, January through October). On the latter, you'll hear stories about the area's colorful past, which includes film shoots, martini flags, shipwrecks, rum-running, and uninsulated thatchroofed shacks.

Japanese American farming families are also an integral part of Crystal Cove's history. A memorial garden near the park's Cultural Center (which once housed a Japanese-language school for local children) is in the works, and a 3-mile stretch of an existing trail will be dedicated as the Go for Broke Trail, honoring Japanese American World War II veterans.
